Palliative Care Tasmania receives \$1.5million from Turnbull Government three year funding Aggreement

Palliative Care Tasmania welcomed the announcement on Friday that the palliative peak body will recieive \$1.5 million over the next three years from the Turnbull Government, as part of a funding deal brokered by the State Government.

PCT General Manager Colleen Johnstone said the funding recognises the value to the community of the great work that has been done by the organisation in the state.

"This funding means that we will be able continue working with the community to increase awareness about end of life issues." Ms Johnstone said.
